## **Journal Decoration Instructions:**

### Materials:

- Blank journal
- Markers
- Crayons
- Colored pencils
- Stickers

### Instructions:

1. Set your journal on a flat surface, like a table, to decorate.
2. Use your imagination to decorate your journal! You can draw, write, color, add stickers--whatever you can dream up. Decorate the cover and maybe some of the pages inside, too.
3. Get ready to get back to school with your fabulous new journal!

## **Face Mask Decoration Instructions:**

### Materials:

- Plain cloth face mask
- Fabric paint
- Non toxic markers

### Instructions:

1. Make sure your face mask is clean and dry (if it came in your kit, it's ready to go).
2. Think of your design. What do you like? What message do you want to send to the world? Get creative!
3. Use markers or paint to put your design on your face mask.
4. Let it dry completely before you wear it.
